

Antioch II Grant Application Instructions

Antioch II is an IRS-recognized supporting organization based in La Crosse, Wisconsin. As a supporting organization, Antioch II has four specific beneficiaries – the Mayo Foundation, the American Red Cross, the Wisconsin Evangelical Lutheran Synod, and Kingdom Workers. Therefore, Antioch II only makes grants in support of these organizations. With respect to grants made in support of WELS, Antioch II only considers organizations and programs that receive operating budget subsidies directly from WELS.

The application deadline is 11:59 PM (US/Central Time) Saturday, September 23rd, 2023. Applications and supporting documentation from ministries that receive WELS operating subsidy should be emailed to the WELS area of ministry administrator. Applications and supporting documentation from the Mayo Foundation, the American Red Cross, and Kingdom Workers should be emailed to: Kurt.Lueneburg@wels.net.

Please review the grant scoring rubric located on the next page prior to submitting your application. All requests will be evaluated using this rubric.

Applications must include the following information:

- Organization name and contact information.
- Organizational summary: A description of the organization, including a brief history.
- **Purpose of grant:** Describe the project for which the request is being made. What demographic will be reached or served by the project?
- Amount of request: The amount being requested of the Antioch Foundation.
- Project budget: Include the total cost of the project as well as a detailed breakdown of the costs involved.
 A separate budget document may be attached to your grant application.
- Other funding sources: What other sources of revenue (beyond The Antioch Foundation) will support this program? How will they be secured? Be sure to include all financial, volunteer, and in-kind contributions.
- **Sustainability plan**: How does your organization plan to continue funding the operation of the program into the future?
- **Expected program outcomes:** What are the primary goals of the program? What changes would those served experience because of your program. (Note: Outcomes are not the same as the activities delivered. For example: training is an activity; the expected outcome would be increased skills or knowledge.)
- **Evaluation strategy:** How will you know if the outcomes you listed above have been achieved? Consider quantitative and/or qualitative evaluation methods.
- Additional information: Is there anything else you would like to tell us about your organization or program?
- **Enclosures:** Please attach a copy of your organization's IRS 501(c)(3) letter along with any other supporting documentation (detailed project budget, letters of support, etc.).

Grant Scoring Rubric

All grant application will be evaluated using the following rubric. Other factors that are unique to specific projects may also be considered.

Other factors not addressed in the scoring:

- 1. Previously received grants from The Antioch Foundation.
- 2. Evidence of successful implementation of previous projects.
- 3. Impact on the project if The Antioch Foundation is only able to partially fund the request.
